**Houki Shiawasenosato**  
200trees



Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April)  
Shidarezakura (Blooming time: Early April - Mid April).  
Many trees are adult trees and beautiful, when they are blooming. Especially, Shidarezakura that grows in colonies are magnificent.



Cherry blossoms symbolize shining life of spring in Japan. The central part of Tottori Prefecture used to be one of the famous places where cherry saplings were grown. We published this map last year and got a good response about it. They are the ruins of Ueshi castle in Yurihama town, Mt. Utubuki in Kurayoshi City, Mt. Cyausu in Hokuei Town Misasa Highland and the colony in Kotoura Town. These places are where we didn't research before and we add the information about 1000 trees. At first we didn't know about the number and the variety of the trees in each area. In the research we recorded the health condition of each tree and reported the information to the administrators. Also we tried to use new tools so that you can browse the detailed data of the cherry blossoms and enjoy the photos and the videos on the website by reading QR code or the photos with smartphones. As the saying goes, the more frequently an Kabuki actor is seen on the stage, the more presence he has. We hope that cherry trees are going to be like this.

**Along Tenjin River**  
310trees

Tago 73 trees Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April)  
Satozakura (Blooming time: Mid April)  
Egita Kita 89 trees Oshimazakura (Blooming time: Early April - Mid April)  
Egita Chuou 35 trees Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) The trees are adults, and spectacular when they are in full bloom.  
Egita minami 53 trees Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) The trees are adult. The scene is spectacular, when they are in full bloom.



**Kotoura Ichibata Park**  
110trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) 70% of the trees is Someiyoshino. There are also Satozakura and Shidarezakura.



**Mt. Senjyo**  
366trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Mid April)  
Satozakura (Blooming time: Mid April) You can see Satozakura around the dam and Someiyoshino along the road. There are also cherry trees such as Kasumizakura, Shidarezakura, Edohiganzakura, Yamazakura and Ezohiganzakura. Some of big trees are worth seeing.



**Yura**  
35trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) The trees have a lot of blossoms. The cherry trees reflected in the surface of Yura river is fantastic.



**Hokueikunisaka Shrine**  
46trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Late March - Early April) About 70% of trees is Someiyoshino. There are also Ezoyamazakura, Yamazakura and Oshimazakura.



**Togo River**  
140trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Late March - Early April) The cherry trees bloom on both sides of Togo River. It is spectacular.



**Fujitsu**  
106trees

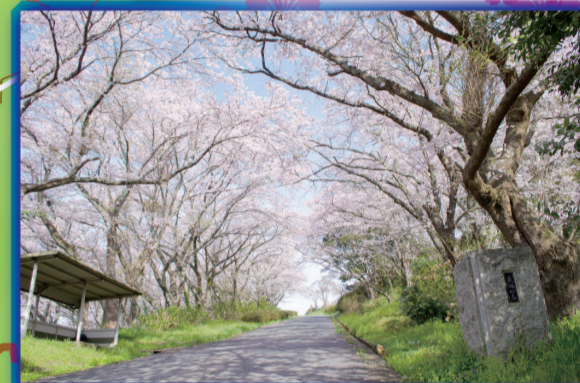
There are 5 kinds of cherry trees including Someiyoshino. (Blooming time: Late March - Mid April) As well as Someiyoshino, Edohiganzakura and Shidarezakura are also beautiful.

**Tomari Primary School**  
219trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) Oshimazakura (Blooming time: Early April - Mid April) Satozakura (Blooming time: Mid April)

**Former Sakura Primary School**  
126trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) The cherry blossoms cover the entire slope. It is spectacular.



**Nishitakao Dam**  
280trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Mid April) Satozakura (Blooming time: Mid April - Late April) The trees of Someiyoshino are being at their peak and bloom beautifully.

**Kurayoshi Agricultural High School**  
152trees

There are 7 kinds of cherry trees including Someiyoshino. (Blooming time: Early April - Late April)

**Along former Kurayoshi Line**  
381trees

Most cherry trees are Someiyoshino, and were planted about 40 years ago. (Blooming time: Early April) The trees have a lot of blossoms.



**Agricultural College**  
150trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April - Mid April) The row of cherry trees along the road have a lot of blossoms. The scene is beautiful. The trees on the college property are old, but have a lot of blossoms.



**Utsubuki Park**  
4000trees

Most cherry trees are Someiyoshino. The park was selected as one of Japan's best 100 locations for cherry blossoms. (Blooming time: Early April)



**Egetani River**  
234trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) The downstream: The trees are adult on the both side of the river. The cherry blossoms are beautiful. The upstream: The trees are growing adult. They are expected to have a lot of blossoms.



**Makisakuradutsumi in Misasa Town**  
123trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April - Mid April) Satozakura (Blooming time: Mid April) The trees are growing adult and expected to be bigger.



**Gokurakuji Temple**  
1tree

Shidarezakura (Late March - Early April) The cherry tree is about 140 years old and 16 meters tall. The trunk of the tree is 3.5 meters in circumference. It is the biggest Shidarezakura tree in Tottori Prefecture.



**Hikiji, Kuhonsan**  
30trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) Edohiganzakura (Blooming time: Late March) Someiyoshino blooms along the IR Line. Edohiganzakura blooms on the mountain side.



**Ueshi-jo castle site**  
193trees

Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April - Mid April) Yamazakura (Blooming time: Early April - Mid April) 60% of the trees is Someiyoshino. You can see Yamazakura near the top of the mountain. There are big trees of Yamazakura along the trail. There are also Kasumizakura, Ezoyamazakura and Uwamizakura.

**Around Misasa Hot Spring**  
253trees

Misasa Hot Spring town 92 trees Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) The big trees that color the town are beautiful. In front of Misasa-Kan 13 trees someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) The cherry trees are big. The trees are spectacular when they are in full bloom. Misasa Highlands 122 trees Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) There are also many Kinkiyamazakura trees. They are wild. Sports Park 26 trees Someiyoshino (Blooming time: Early April) Satozakura (Blooming time: Mid April) These two kinds of cherry trees bloom in different seasons. The trees of Satozakura are big.
